Step One:










- Log on to Parent or Student Portal.

- Choose your favorite electives to complete the required eight credits.

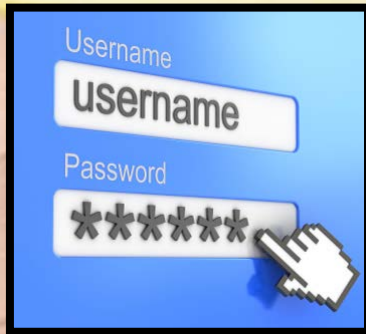
Step Seven:
